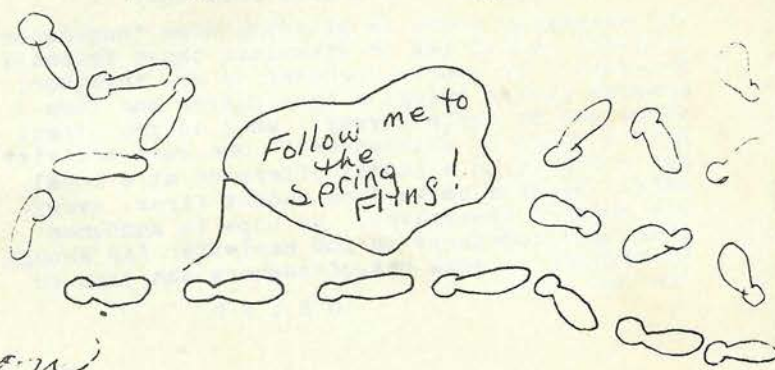

TALLAHASSEE Let me take this opportunity on behalf of the Tallahassee folk dancers to thank Julius and his Folkdancefest Committee for doing such a wonderful job. We know firsthand the labor that is involved and appreciate you all for "taking on the challenge" in 1985.

We heard from Roman Stanley, an old-time Tallahassee dancer who now lives, works and dances with the Pensacola group headed up by Larry-Lou Foster. We old-timers miss Roman dearly and pray that he'll someday travel eastward to pay us a visit.

Tallahassee group is considering the feasibility of having Folkdancefest '86 here in Tallahassee. In order to conclude our study of available dates your input is required. A local concert hall named the "Musical Moon" has asked if we could perform on a Sunday afternoon or are we locked into dancing only on Saturday evenings. The simple advantage to this concert hall is that it is privately-owned and all the arrangements such as advertising, ticket-selling and production itself, including announcer, would be their responsibility. We might even be able to recover out travel expenses.

If we agree to perform Sunday afternoon, we pretty much can select the date we want. If you vote for Saturday night only, dates may not be as available. Please give some consideration to the Sunday afternoon alternative on a holiday weekend when we have Monday off. I feel we would be able to negotiate a better deal with the Musical Moon management for a Sunday matinee performance.

THE ST. BONIFACE FOLK DANCERS OF SARASOTA were hosts to two folk dancers-musicians: Anja Meyer and Martin Junghans, from near Bremen, Germany, this spring. The Whiteheads presented a special evening program for all of us: "AN AMERICAN EXPERIENCE". We are slowly coming to realize how we have disregarded our own heritage and the gold that is near at hand. Cubby Whitehead doing his "old timey" program is priceless! Europeans would love it and perhaps someday Floridians will discover what talent is locally available.

Our folk dance group here has gradually improved and can now do more complicated dances. Our main performance this year was a 30-minute program at a Chinese New Year's Dinner in honor of the Consul General. We did an American wite we call "From Maine to Mexico" plus a dance from each of the large ethnic groups who were attending the dinner: French, Israeli and Greek.

As a result of seeing the enthusiasm of some Europeans for anything American, we have discovered America: we are working on developing a set of American dances to teach in Europe this summer.

We leave from Tampa June 7 and fly to London. We plan to sightsee in London, then visit friends in Kent, the Cotswolds and Coventry. We may take an organized bus tour of Wales before leaving by train or bus for Zurich to meet Tina Figi (our Swiss dancing friend) and drive with her through northern Italy to Trieste and into Istria to the little of Bale, where a ten-day "stage de dance serb" will be held. The day the Serbian course ends, we'll go to Zagreb and take a plane to Athens, where we'll meet a French dance group on its way to the island of Lesbos for another ten-day course in Greek dances.

Alain (our dancing friend from Paris) has invited us to visit him in Paris, again, reminding us that there is more to see, mentioning Rheims, Rouen, Fontainebleu. Our short stay with him last August was a whirlwind of sight-seeing and gourmet picnics.

At the end of August, we hope to attend a seminar in Aix-en-Privence and perhaps be able to squeeze in a day or so at the folk festival in Dijon before returning to London for our flight home Sept 6.

We deeply enjoy traveling. Metro is very good at striking up conversations, getting acquainted, and learning from people the information so priceless to travelers. We find kindred spirits everywhere, although occasionally we goof. In a way, we take 9 months topprepare for our 3-month expeditions. There is so much to learn before you can decide what areas to visit, what activities to try and what people to get involved with.

We'll write again when we return. Meanwhile we would love to hear from you. Write us UNTIL JULY 1: c/o Tina Figi
